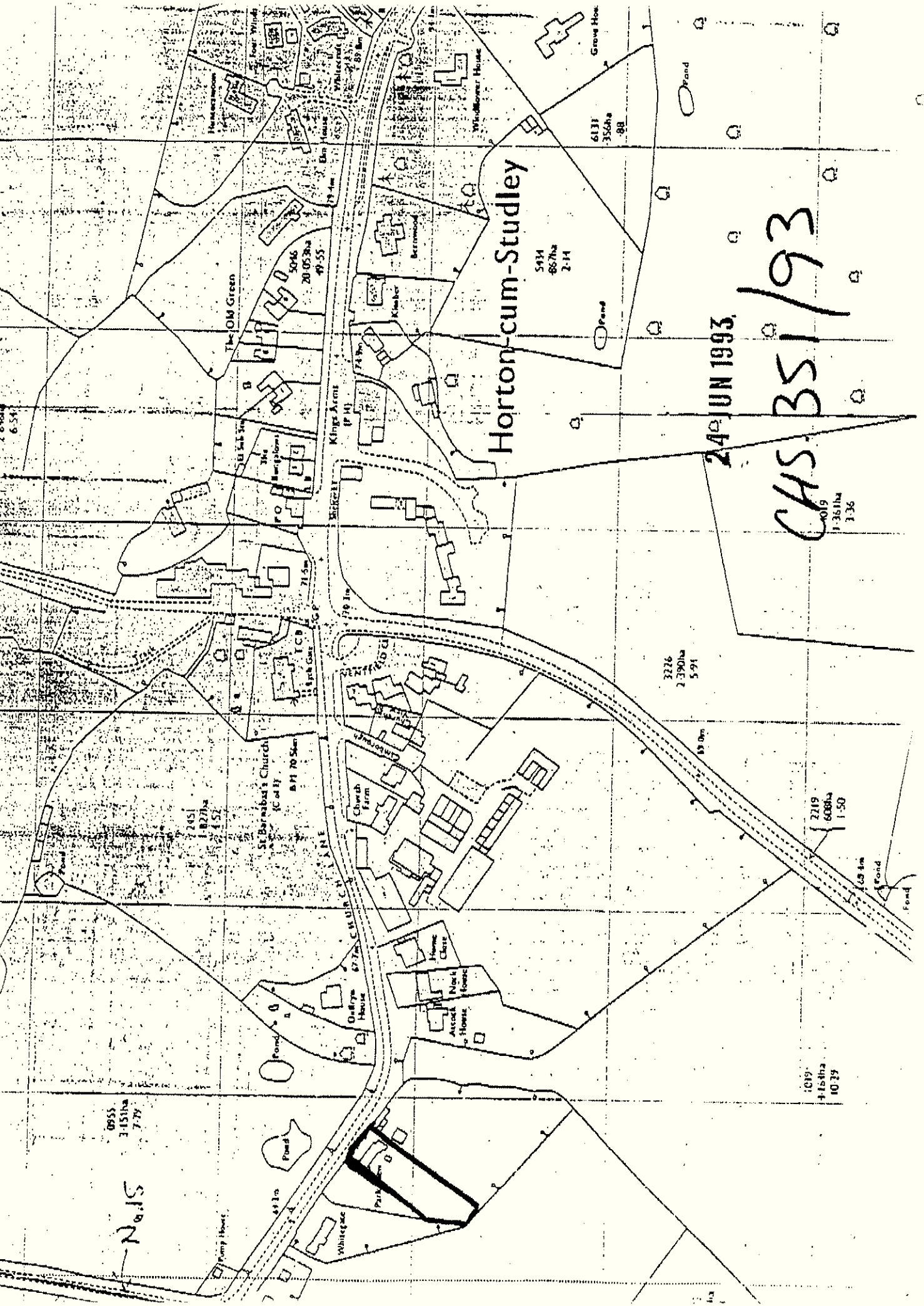
Park View, Horton-cum-Studeley, Watching Brief

Grid ref (SP 5906 1242)

A site visit was made on the 13th September 1993 in order to inspect the open trench footings of the house extension. The house is S of earthworks from the shrunken medieval village of Horton-cum-Studeley. A verbal report and aerial photographs indicate a roughly rectangular ditched or moated enclosure with ridge and furrow to the N of the road which are probably related to the shrunken medieval village (Oxon CC PRN 12735).

The open trenches were inspected and a sample section was cleaned. The excavated spoil and the landscaped topsoil from the garden was monitored for artefacts. There were no significant archaeological deposits. A modern pit was seen at the SE corner of the open trenches underneath the modern topsoil.
