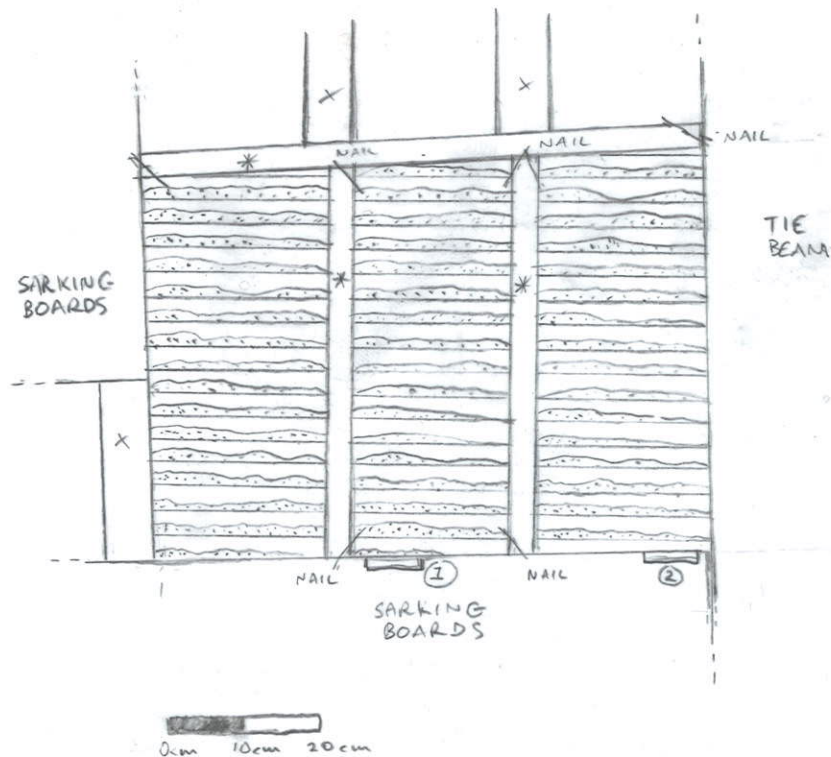

QUEEN'S HOUSE

NOTES - AREA IS APPROXIMATELY 75cm x 55cm. LATER TIMBERS ARE FIXED TO ORIGINAL CARPENTRY ROUGHLY WITH DIAGONAL NAILS. TIMBERS ARE FIXED OVER LATHS WITH COARSE WHITE PLASTER BENEATH. MORTICES FOR ORIGINAL JOISTS CAN BE SEEN AT ① AND ②. THESE OUT OF LINE WITH JOISTS TO WEST OF AREA, PERHAPS THESE WERE MOVED WHEN LATER TIMBERS WERE INSERTED

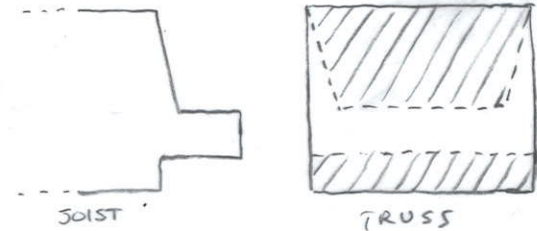
- GOVERNOR'S HOUSE ROOF
