Nero A.D.65 semis R.I.C.397 (*SF* 26 *Context* 513/*F*/2)

Semisses are rare as site finds in Britain, generally coming from military sites. The occurrence of such a coin at Mount Farm is therefore unusual, particularly as the site has yielded no other coins. It is presumably evidence for intercourse between the inhabitants of the site and a nearby Roman garrison.
