MARCHAM WILLOW FARM 1994

WATCHING BRIEF

NGR SP 4590/9645 MWF 94

An Archaeological Watching Brief was carried out by the Oxford Archaeological Unit on 3rd June 94 on behalf of the County Archaeological Services.

Possible human remains were reported to the coroners office at Abingdon. The OAU was asked to investigate. Bones were observed protruding from a drainage ditch section which was roughly orientated east/west within the Willow Farm property. Willow Farm is situated to the south-east of Marcham.

The bones were exposed due to the process of water and duck erosion to the bank of modern ground level. The bones were identified by a specialist as leg bones from a cow :- a distal tibia, an astragalus and a calcaneum.
