**Publication reports for clay tobacco pipe from Little Martins Field, Brightwell-cum-Sotwell, Oxon (BRLMF 18)**

A single piece of clay pipe stem was recovered. This is fully described and dated below.

**Context (2309) Spot-date: Later 17th century to early 18th century**

Description: A single very fresh stem fragment (5g), of 'chunky' early type. Surviving length 56mm. Very clean white fabric. Smooth but unburnished. Stem bore diameter of c 2.6mm.
