	Wed 29th 7pm	<b>Cambridge Castle</b> Guided walk round the archaeology of Shire Hall. Meet outside Shire Hall main entrance (CB3 0AP).
JUL	Wed 13th 7pm	<b>Huntingdon</b> Guided walk tracing the occupation and human impact along the riverside. Meet outside the entrance of the Cromwell Museum (PE29 3LF).
