

Pond 1698 NOPM25EX

Pond 1698 was excavated in two phases during July and August 2010 covering a total of 1ha. The site was located to the south of the M25, east of chequers road bridge and centred around TQ 547 941. The site sloped to the south-east, towards the motorway from 48m aOD at the highest point to 42m aOD at the lowest and prior to excavation was in use for both agricultural and grazing land. The site was excavated using the SMS methodology which involved the mechanical excavation of the current plough or topsoil to a natural deposit of London Clay, Silt and Sand.

No archaeological remains were encountered.
